

e-Payments: A great new way to pay for school trips and events.

To help make it as easy as possible for you to pay for school trips and events we have introduced an e-payments system which allows you to pay for school trips and events over the internet. If you prefer to continue to pay by cash or cheque, these options are still available.

Advantages to parents

- No cash to find or cheques to write.
- 24 hour service.
- Straightforward and easy to use.
- Avoids the risk of your child losing cash on the way to school

How to pay

All major debit or credit cards are accepted with the exception of American Express and Diners Card. To pay online you will need the following details to hand:

Your questions answered

Will I be charged for using my credit/debit card?

There is no charge for using a debit card but there is a 1.3% charge when a credit card is used.

I have more than one child attending the same school; do I have to make separate payments?

Yes. A single payment cannot be split across more than one account. You will need to make separate payments to each account.

Can I still pay for trips and events by cheque or cash?

Yes. We will still accept cash and cheques but we prefer parents to use e-payments as it is a secure system and more efficient for the school.

Gift Aid:

As you will be aware trips and events can only take place if there are enough voluntary contributions. With this in mind there is a facility on the e-payment page to gift aid your contribution. If you are a UK tax payer please can you tick this box. All proceeds from gift aid will go back into school funds to be used to benefit all our pupils.
