Actions
<p>Curriculum Support and Organisation-</p> <p>Smaller sets in all year groups for students below Level 4 on entry to continue enabling targeted literacy and numeracy work.</p> <p>Increased number of literacy lessons for students below Level 4 on entry to continue.</p> <p>Discrete teaching of literacy within the Key Stage 3 curriculum for all students to continue.</p> <p>Dedicated leadership time for literacy and numeracy.</p> <p>Form Time activities are now being developed to enable students to work together on literacy and numeracy activities.</p>
<p>Parental Engagement</p> <p>Literacy input to all Year 7 & 8 parents at the Parent Guidance meetings, to promote reading and spelling programmes.</p> <p>Basic skills support workshops (both literacy and numeracy) for parents of students below Level 4 on entry.</p>
<p>Reading Intervention</p> <p>Testing of all students on entry to continue.</p> <p>Intervention programme for students who are well below chronological reading ages to continue.</p> <p>Peer readers are working alongside younger students to support and expand the reading intervention programme.</p>
<p>Spelling Intervention</p> <p>Testing of all students on entry to continue.</p> <p>Intervention programme for students who are well below chronological reading ages to continue.</p>
<p>Staff Training and Development</p> <p>Specific training days to promote literacy and numeracy across all subject areas to continue.</p> <p>Staff Focus Groups to carry forward work on literacy and maths across the curriculum meeting the needs of students with additional needs in 2015-2016.</p>
<p>Summer School Transition Programme</p> <p>Literacy and numeracy themed enrichment and intervention targeted at Pupil Premium students and those identified as below Level 4 on entry will continue.</p>
